Vineyard, a white graduate student, were turned away from their confirmed hotel reservations to attend the MAA Southeastern Section meeting in Columbia, SC; and

Whereas this action was inconsistent with the Association's affirmation of its intention to conduct its affairs without discrimination and with this Section's desire to be a place for all who love mathematics:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the MAA Southeastern Section hereby extends its sincerest apologies to Bill Brodie and all we have turned away for their exclusion from the activities of this Section.

Be it further resolved that the MAA Southeastern Section warmly welcomes Mr. Brodie, and people of all backgrounds, to this and to all future meetings, events, and activities, and looks forward to their contributions and participation; and

Be it finally resolved, that the MAA Southeastern Section reaffirms its commitment to creating a welcoming and inclusive environment for all its members and for all who love mathematics.

Adopted this 15 day of March, 2024, by the membership of the MAA Southeastern Section.






